

# ISSB Interview Questions and Answers

Questions in ISSB Interview are not that much tricky. ISSB Interview Questions are just like any other interview. Interviews are conducted to check the behavioral and psychological aspects of an individual. ISSB Interview Questions are of importance because interviews give you more chance of being selected as compared to other tests.

There are different types of questions in the interview. Just like other interviews your background and personal information is taken, apart from this, general knowledge and current affairs are frequently asked in the ISSB Interviews. ISSB Interview Questions are analyzed on the basis of:

- 10% of what you say
- 20% of the tone of voice
- 70% of body image

## ISSB Interview Questions

Some of the major categories are given below and samples of questions are also given for your better ISSB Preparation:

### Personal Life Questions in ISSB Interview:

One should have fully prepared for the different questions about their own personal life and the interviewing officer will put some stress on you regarding your personal life and personal life questions do not mean that

what is your name and your age the officer could ask different questions like:

- From where your parents belong to
- What is the anniversary date of your parents
- How you parents meet each other
- Questions about your Father occupation
- Questions about your mother occupations
- How Many Sisters and brother you have and their date of birth
- Do you ever quarreled with your sister or brother and what is the reason behind that
- If you have a sister then why she is not married yet
- What is the total income of your father from all sources
- What are your grandfather occupation and their income as well

### **Academic Career Questions in ISSB Interview:**

Academic career of each candidate explains a lot to the interviewing officer so that is why here you do have to face some difficulties if you have any kind of ambiguity. Questions asked in that section could be like:

- What are your favorite subjects and why they are favorite
- Why are you really good at some specific subject, not others
- What are your total marks obtained in the Matric Class
- What is the total number of percentage you got in Matric
- Marks obtained in the Intermediate examination
- From where you have completed your matric education, Address of your school
- Why you do not like this subject

- If you have failed or got supply in one subject then why

## Self-Analysis Questions in ISSB Interview:

Many awkward and weird questions are asked for self-analysis of candidates. These questions may seem odd to you but they are asked to analyze your behavior and thoughts related to any perspective. Some of the samples asked till today are:

- Do you lie
- If I give you Rs. 500000, what will you do?
- Why do you want to join Pakistan Army/Air Force/Navy?
- Are you in a relationship?
- If married, what type of husband you are?
- How many girlfriends/boyfriends do you have?
- Have you ever been into a sexual relationship?
- Will you give me your girlfriend for one night?
- I want to marry your sister, what will you do?
- You are among friends which you don't like, what will you do?
- Why do you want to join?
- What if you get rejected?

## Mathematical Questions in ISSB Interview:

There are many mind bluster questions about the mathematical formulas regarding Weight, Time, Space, and Speed.

For Example: Which of the following values is NOT equal to  $34(58+9)$ ?

- A.  $34 \times 67$  **Ans = 2278**

- B.  $58(34+9)$  **Ans = 2494**
- C.  $34 \times 58 + 34 \times 9$  **Ans = 2278**
- D.  $1,972 + 306$  **Ans = 2278**
- E.  $(9 + 58) 34$  **Ans = 2278**
- If Plane is going with 90 km/hour Speed then in 35 Mint how much distance will it cover? **Ans = 52.5**
- What is 5% of 75? **Ans = 3.75**
- If your monthly income is 2200 then what will be your yearly income? **Ans = 26400**
- The price of 1 dozen eggs is Rs. 22 than what will be the price of 30 eggs? **Ans = 55**
- Which is bigger  $\frac{2}{3}$  or  $\frac{4}{5}$ ? **Ans =  $\frac{4}{5}$**
- The speed of an aircraft is 180 km/h, how much the aircraft travel in 20 minutes? **Ans = 60**
- What is the 20% of 240? **Ans = 48**

### Physics Questions in ISSB Interview:

The subject questions will form from the syllabus book as all they have read in the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th Class so that is why if you have full grip on all the Law in the physic book then you could easily complete this category the questions normally asked from that section are about the Newton 1st Law, Newton 2nd Law, Newton 3rd Law, Boyle's Law, Charles Law, Resonance and other all topics in books.

### Social Life Questions in ISSB Interview:

The questions asked in that portion of Interview are all about your social life that means how you spend your life when you are outside of your home. The Questions in that category would be like

- Do you have an account on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram
- Who is your best friend and why
- Number of total friends you have
- Good habit of some specific person in your friend list
- How many female friends you have on your Facebook or any other social media

### **Pakistan Studies Questions in ISSB Interview:**

In ISSB Test an interviewing officer have much concern about the thing that how much you know Pakistan and its issues. Most of the ISSB Officer says that how could we recommend a person who did not know about his own country. The most of the questions asked in that category of ISSB Interview is about the Pakistan border and it could be Pakistan Afghanistan Border length, Pak China Border length, Pak India Border length so do know the Pakistan Borderline information before you go to the ISSB Test Centers in Pakistan.

### **Religious Questions in ISSB Interview:**

Religious questions in the Interview should be like

- What is the difference between Nabwi and Hijri
- What is the total number of Ayaat in the Quran
- Total Numbers of Surah in the Quran
- Kaleb-ul-Quran is known which surat

- In which Hijri Ghazwa-e-Badr were fought

Abbreviations can also be asked from the candidates that what is the abbreviation of:

- ISSB (Inter Services Selection Board)
- CSS (Central Superior Services)
- SIM (Subscriber Information Module)

- IP (Internet Protocol)
- DOS (Disk Operating System)
- GSM (Global System for Mobile)
- PSO (Pakistan State Oil)
- OGDCL (Oil and Gas Development Company)
- PAEC (Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission)

## Pak Armed Forces Questions in ISSB Interview:

If you are going with a wish to join the armed forces of Pakistan then you should have basic knowledge about the armed forces as an officer to ask you questions. The questions in that section of the interview would be like

- On which date did Captain Muhammad Sarwar awarded by the Nishan-e-Haider in Pakistan **Ans = 16 March 1957**
- Who is the chief of army staff
- Army captain is equal to which naval officer rank in Pakistan **Ans = Lieutenant**

- Who is the chief commanding officer of Pakistan Air Force
- Who is the chief Commanding officer of Pakistan Navy
- What is the role of our Pak Armed Forces in Indo Pak Wars Yet?
